We have adapted and recieved training to ensure they can cater for some complex needs, this has included bolus feeding, suctioning, epi pen training and we have implemented PECs. Staff have worked closely with speech and language therapists, portage as well as many other professionals to ensure that they are a truly inclusive setting.

Training is an ongoing process and is

reviewed periodically or when they are aware of any changes to a child's needs.

We work closely with the parents as they know their child best and this is done in line with observation and assessment. . We remain to have close links with other professionals and other settings to create and maintain a positive partnership to benefit the child.
